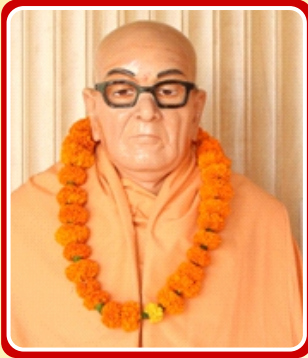

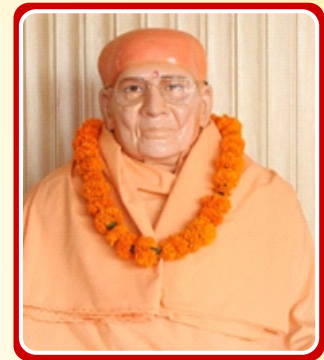
## The HHS Movement: A HISTORICAL PEPERCTIVE

### **Admission Rules:**

1. A student who is seeking admission in the school will be registered only after the completed admission form with all the relevant documents submitted in the school.
2. Based on the admission test, students seeking admission first time have to provide proof of Date of Birth Certificate, Aadhar card, SLC, 4- Passport size photographs.
3. The age criteria for Play-way is 2.5 years.
4. The Admission process will be completed under three ways (i) Entrance test (ii) Interview with Co-ordinator (iii) Last & final interview of students and Parents with Principal.

### **General Rules:**

1. Parents must not enter the classroom to see their wards or teacher during the class hours.
2. They can only meet the teachers on PTM days or with prior appointment, for any medical problem, the Parents must inform the school prior to the session.
3. Any communication by the parents with the teachers, should be addressed to the Principal.
4. Student will not be allowed to go home or with any other person except only with mother or father or blood relation.
5. School Fees should be deposited by the 10th date of every month, after that 50 Rs will be charged as fine.
6. Fighting, using abusive language or any anti-social behaviour is strictly prohibited, student may be suspended after three warnings.
7. Class-incharge will have to inform in Principal office, if any student is continuously absent since three days.
